

MIRACLE WORKERS

I Corinthians 12:10 "To another the working of miracles."

The Greek words are "energema dunamis"

Energema – an operation or working; where we get the word "energy".

Dunamis – ability, abundance, might, power, miracle, strength, mighty work, where we get the word "dynamite".

Paul was saying that the working of miracles is the:

"Energy of Dynamite" "Explosion of Power"

In this gift, God works the miraculous through man.

Dunamis is also translated "**The handling of power.**"

Or power that is in your hand.

The power that's spoken of here is actually the creative power of God.

Acts 4:22 For the man was above forty years old, on whom this miracle of healing was shewed. **KJV**

Mark 5:30 And Jesus, immediately knowing in himself that **virtue** (energy) had gone out of him, turned him about in the press, and said, Who touched my clothes? **KJV**

Luke 6:19 And the whole multitude sought to touch him: for there went virtue out of him, and healed them all. **KJV**

Luke 8:46 And Jesus said, Somebody hath touched me: for I perceive that virtue is gone out of me. **KJV**

Virtue = excellence of soul. But we're talking about another type of virtue

Virtue = Dunamis – inherent power, power residing in a thing by virtue of its nature, or which a person or thing exerts and puts forth, power for performing miracles.

It's a noun word. A person, place, or thing; an object.

It's a verb word. A word that denotes action

Doonamahee = have power through **favourable** circumstances or by permission of law.

Miracle is the virtue of God flowing out of you into something or someone.

Acts 10:38 KJV; Matthew 10: 7-8 KJV

Luke 9:1 Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases. **KJV**

We all have the virtue of God, miracles in our hands but until you work the miracle it remains a noun and not a verb.

You must release the miracle power of God in your body unto others.

It's the process of working a miracle.

Matthew 8:2-4 NASB

Touch. Gone and Went. Miracles and healings.

Habakkuk 3:3-4 God comes from Teman, And the Holy One from Mount Paran. Selah. His splendor covers the heavens, And the earth is full of His praise. His radiance is like the sunlight; **He has rays flashing from His hand, And there is the hiding of His power. NASB**

It is used of a sudden flash of lightning

Passion for God and a compassion for people

Greater love = greater works

Acts 3:6 Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have (virtue) give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.

7 And he took him by the right hand, and lifted him up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength.

8 And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God. **KJV**

Acts 4:30 By stretching forth thine hand (our hand, His power) to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy Holy Child Jesus.

33 And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all. **KJV**

Luke 7:1-10 The Message

Jesus was touched by the word of faith that came from the tongues of the centurion and the syro-phonician woman.

Both released miracle working power by touching the heart of Jesus and then Jesus touched the one they stood in proxy for with a miracle working word.

Jesus was willing to go to touch the centurion's servant. But the centurion understood authority to perform miracles using the tongue that formed words.

Mark 7:24-30 The Message

Syro-phoenician woman had to work hard to receive a miracle.

She wasn't lazy!

Neither should we!
